The ICC Sydney, a premier, state-of-the-art venue, offers an exceptional harbourside setting in the heart of Australia's most cosmopolitan city for this global event.

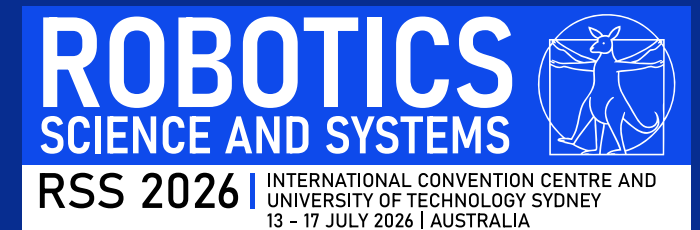

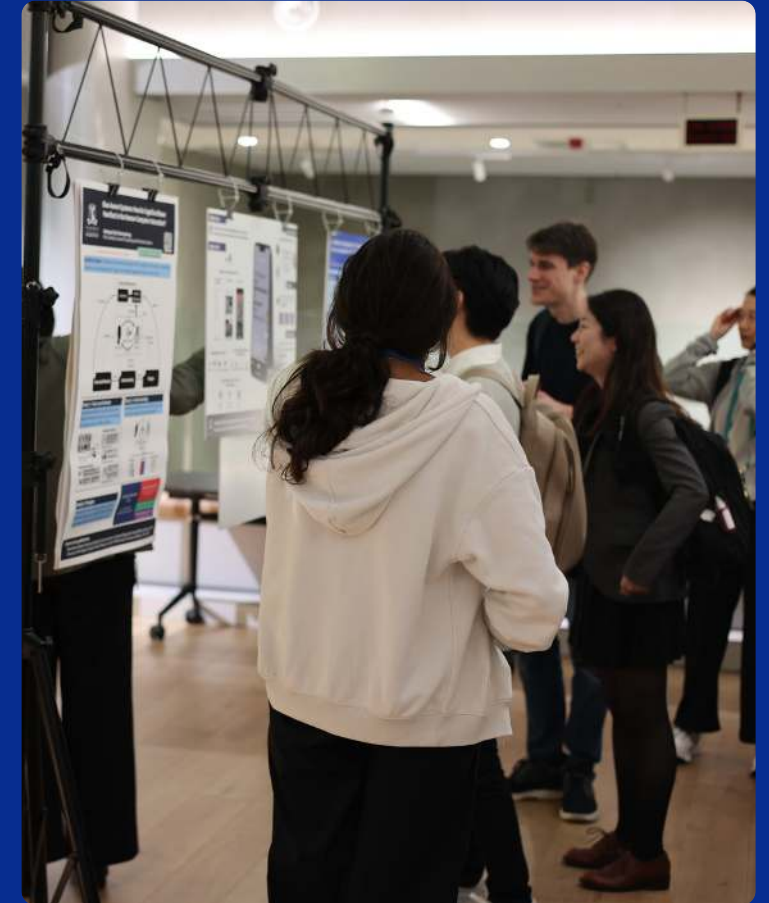
Early-Career Researcher Opportunities

Pathways@RSS 2026

The Robotics: Science and Systems (RSS) community recognises the importance of supporting early-career researchers and students in robotics. Such efforts are essential for fostering innovation, strengthening research capacity, and broadening the impact of robotics on society. To that end, Pathways@RSS is a key part of RSS 2025, focusing on initiatives that help prospective and early-career researchers develop their skills and thrive within the robotics community.

These initiatives include co-located events and dedicated activities throughout the main conference. Pathways fellowships will be awarded to selected BSc, MSc and first and second-year PhD students. Priority will be given to students who have not previously attended RSS and/or are new to the robotics research community.
